



Governance and President's Office Professionals (GPOP) Award for Distinguished Service

The Award for Distinguished Service recognizes the significant personal and professional contributions made by a current or past member to the Governance and President's Office Professionals (GPOP).

This award is bestowed upon a current, or former, member of GPOP whose dedicated service has improved and enhanced the presence of the organization in the higher education community. Honorees shall be current or former members of GPOP/PBSN and PBSN/PNPA who have contributed to the growth, development, and overall progress of the profession.

Selection criteria include:

- The nominee is a current, or former, member of and has had a significant and positive impact on GPOP.
- The nominee has demonstrated consistent and ongoing commitment to the organization.
- The nominee's accomplishments should be varied.
- The nominee's activities should serve to enhance the image of or to foster improvements in GPOP.
- The nominee has served as a role model and mentor to new governance and president's office professionals.
- Members of the GPOP Board Executive Committee (Chair, Chair Elect, Secretary/Treasurer) shall be ineligible for this Award.
- The current Chair and Members of the GPOP Awards & Recognition Committee shall be ineligible for this award.

A maximum of three letters of support should be included.
